Description:

Two-page document, on stamp-impressed paper with the stamp of "República Peruana" ("Republic of Peru"), cursive italic writing in ink. The two pages, one of which has original page number "15", present on the recto sides, stamped header with inscription: "Un cuarto (4th part of a Real) / Sello cuarto (Fourth seal) for the years / 1829 and 1830"; on the left side, circular seal with inscription: "REPUBLICA PERUANA" ("REPUBLIC OF PERU") On the back of page 15 presents the first deed of sale granted by María Mónica Rodríguez to Diego Espinosa, of some lands of sowing in the area of Pongo Chico in Huaylas, before Gaspar Jurado, in Lima (09/18/1829); likewise, a second deed of power of attorney granted by Mariano Santos de Quiroz to José Domingo Castro, prosecutor, to defend him in (his) lawsuits, before Gaspar Jurado, in Lima (09/21/1829); also, a third deed with a letter of freedom granted by Clara León, wife of Manuel Chávez, in favor of her mulatto female slave Gertrudis, before Gaspar Jurado, in Lima (09/22/1829). The recto side of the second page [16], shows the continuation of the third deed; likewise, a fourth deed of power of attorney granted by Juan Mariano Cosío, lawyer, to his mother Manuela [illegible], so that she could collect some botijas (earthenware jugs) left as legacy to her by Alberto Cevallos in the town of [Poros], before Gaspar Jurado, in Lima (5 October 1829); on the back of the second page [16], there is a continuation of the fourth deed; there is also a fifth deed of power of attorney granted by Jacoba Echao to José María Trujillo so that he could collect his debts and represent her in her lawsuits before Gaspar Jurado in Lima ([10]/29/1829, error in date by the scribe); there is also the first line of a sixth deed granted by the merchant Fabián Gómez.

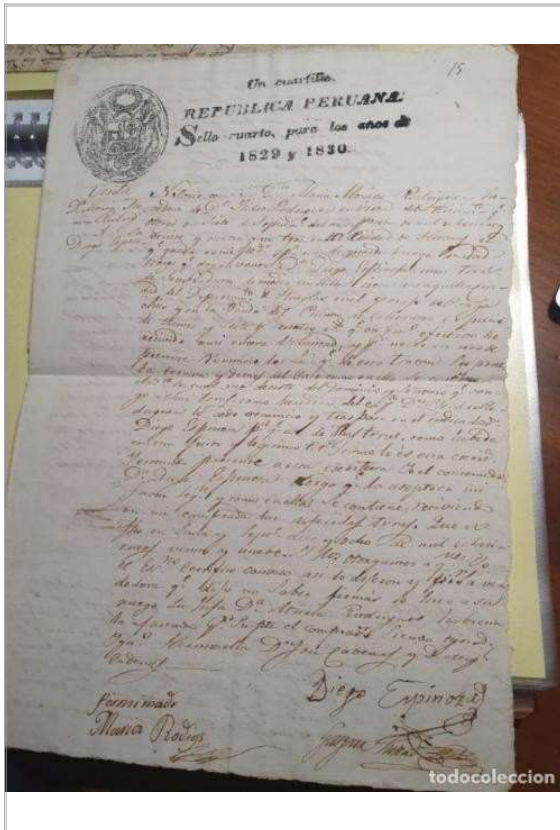


Image: Page 1, front view

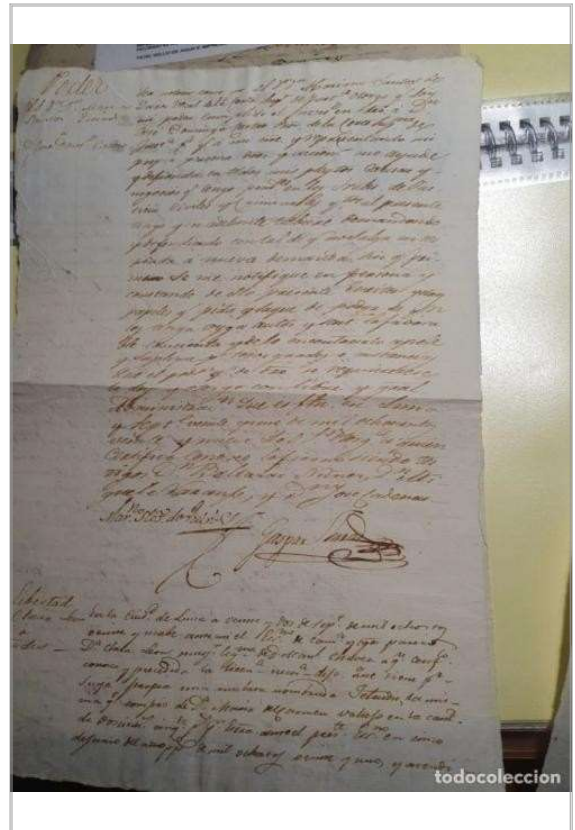


Image: Page 1, rear view

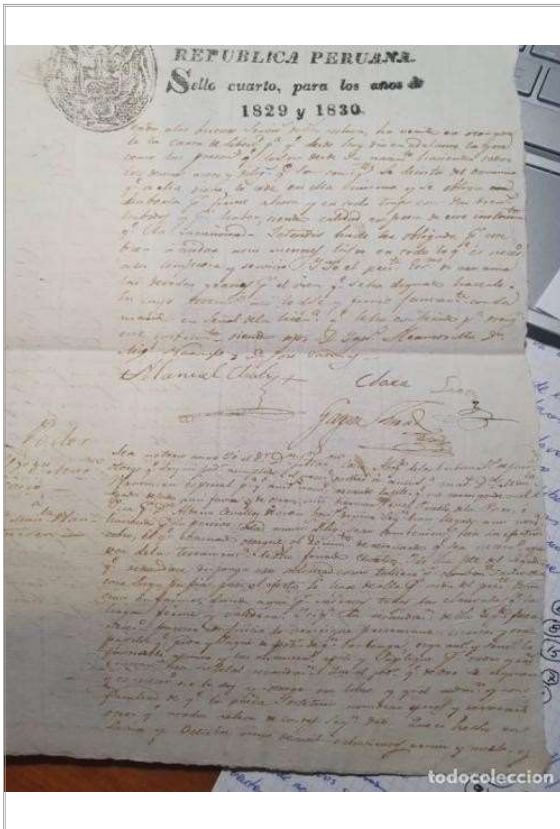


Image: Page 2, front view

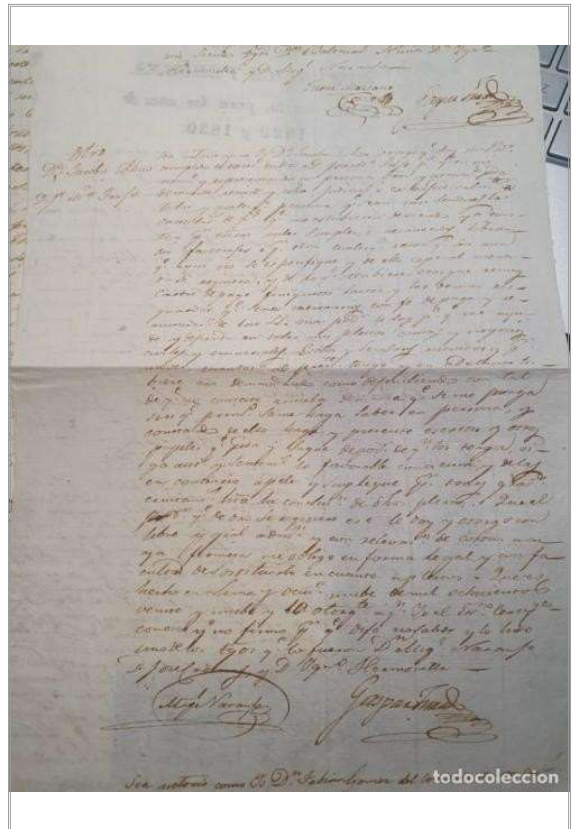


Image: Page 2, rear view
